Feeding Guide:

- The average rabbit requires approximately 100-150g of food each day, depending on size and breed.
- Only put out enough food as will be consumed in one day, to avoid selective feeding.
- Green foods such as broccoli, cabbage, celery leaves and carrot tops can be fed from time to time, but should be washed before feeding. Hay or grass should be available throughout the day.
- Fresh fruit should be fed only as a treat in limited quantities.
- Any change in diet should be made gradually, over 7 - 14 days, to allow the rabbit's digestive system to become accustomed to the new food.
- Twigs can be provided to help keep teeth in good order and provide mental stimulation.

Guinea Pig Food

Includes dried grass and added vitamin C to benefit your pet.

Feeding Guide:

- The average guinea pig requires approximately 30-50g of food each day, depending on size and breed.
- Only put out enough food as will be consumed in one day to avoid selective feeding.
- Fresh vegetables, grasses and dandelions can be provided as a treat, but should be washed before feeding. Hay or grass should be available throughout the day.

Hamster, Mouse and Gerbil Food

Suitable for a variety of small, sociable rodents.

Feeding Guide:

- The average hamster requires approximately 7-12g of food each day, with mice and gerbils requiring around 5-7g. This can vary according to the size and breed.
- Only put out enough food as will be consumed in one day to avoid selective feeding.
- Hamsters and gerbils will enjoy fresh vegetables such as carrots, cucumber, lettuce and apples. Do not feed acid fruits. Hay should be available throughout the day.

Hygiene: When handling your pet it is important to maintain a hygienic environment:

- Ensure feeding bowls and water dispensers are cleaned regularly with warm water and ideally a safe disinfectant.
- Wear gloves and wash your hands thoroughly after handling products.

For all your pets, please ensure that fresh drinking water is made available at all times, and checked at least twice a day.
